

Below is a list of all Minority-Serving Institutions (MSIs) in the US that provided physics degrees (Bachelors, Masters, and/or PhDs) between the 2015-2016 and 2019-2020 academic years inclusive. More information on Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs), including those that do not grant physics degrees, can be found [here](#). To generate the lists of physics degree-granting Predominantly Black Institutions (PBIs), Hispanic Serving Institutions (HSIs), Native American-Serving Nontribal Institutions (NASNTI), and Alaska Native and Native Hawaiian-Serving Institutions (ANNH), we use data from the FY 2022 [Eligibility Matrix by the Department of Education](#), which determines institution eligibility for these designations based on student enrollments and non-Federal cost-sharing requirements (see the link for more details). We include institutions that are both eligible for new funding per the Eligibility Matrix as well as institutions with open grants. Finally, we also provide lists based on only student enrollments (based on Fall 2019 counts, which were used in the FY 2022 Eligibility Matrix) for institutions with at least 25% enrollment by Black or African American students and for institutions with at least 25% enrollment by Hispanic students.
